Dr. G.S.Aulakh graduated with a BS in Agriculture in 1958 from Khalsa College, Amritsar, Panjab. In 1965, he migrated to the United Kingdom. Before moving to the United States of America in 1970, he had completed his postgraduate Teachers Training from Jordan Hill College of Education, Glasgow, Scotland. He then taught general science for one year. After arriving in the US he did his MS in Genetics from North Carolina Central University, Durham, NC, and his PhD from Howard University, Washington, D.C. Subsequently, he did his post doctorate assignment at the National Institute of Health, Bethesda, MD, and was a Senior Staff Fellow at the Bureau of Biologics as a special expert in the laboratory of Oral Medicine. He was the first scientist to demonstrate the presence of virus related genes in human tumor tissues and absence in the normal tissue from the same patient, thus postulating the viral etiology of cancer. He did this pioneering work in the Tumor Cell...
