He graduated at West Point in 1840, and entered the army as a lieutenant of artillery. He served in Florida and during the Mexican war in California, but seeing no immediate chance for promotion, he resigned in 1853 and became a banker in San Francisco. When the Civil War broke out he was head of the Louisiana Military Academy. In May, 1861, he became a colonel of infantry, and after the battle of Bull Run was appointed brigadier-general of volunteers. In August of the latter year having been sent to Kentucky, he demanded 200,000 men for offensive operations, but in this was regarded as a visionary and was relieved of his command.
